Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2009



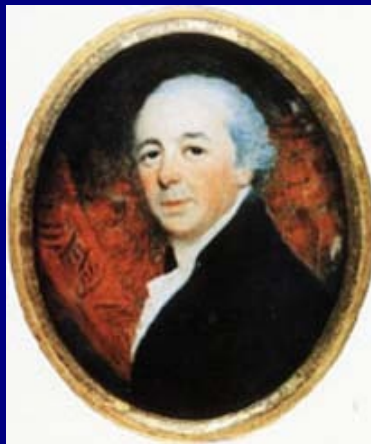

**A talk on John Nash by Richard Suggett  
of the RCAHMW and a tour of the new  
Ceredigion and Assembly Buildings,  
Aberystwyth**

The day will start at 12pm with a tour of the Royal Commission of Ancient and Historic Monuments Wales building where we will be able to look at archive material. In addition Richard Suggett, Manager of the Emergency Building Recording Team, will give us a talk on the life and works of the famous Prince Regent's Architect, John Nash.

Not strictly a historic building, but it will be one day! RICS Wales have organised a tour of the new Ceredigion & Assembly Building, and as IHBC members we are also able to attend. The tour will start at 3pm and will last for approximately 1.5 hours. This will be followed by a buffet with the RICS members at the Park Lodge Hotel. ## A tour of Llanelly House, Llanelli

Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2009



One of Llanelli's most historic properties, this fine example of an early 18<sup>th</sup> Century Georgian Town house, which is now in a poor state of repair, was bought in 1998 by the Town Council with the object of completely restoring it. In 2002 it was one of the finalists in the first series of BBC 1's Restoration programme. Since that time a significant amount of money has been secured from various sources, including Cadw and the Heritage Lottery Fund, to restore the property. These works commence in November 2009, and as IHBC members we are being offered a tour of the property prior to the commencement of these works. This tour will be given by the Project Officer. There will then be a follow up visit after the works have been completed. This tour will cost £5, all of which will be donated to the restoration fund.
