ARQUITECTURA DE UNA DÉCADA



“Sevilla 1995-2005. Arquitectura de una década” has been presented during the IV Week of Architecture, activity promoted every year by COAS and Foundation FIDAS from 2001.

Around two hundred and fifty works builded in Seville province between 1995 and 2005 are distributed by theme in an exhibition that starts covering some of the best works realized in this decade over past architectures: from those small realized on archeological complex, to project on renovation of domestic and public architecture, or restoration of huge monuments. The interventions over the Time are followed by those realized over the Space, focalizing the exhibition on manipulation that consciously Architecture is able to exercise over the landscape, natural or urban.



The exhibition core is organized around two parallel selections: more than 30 projects presented exhaustively with those that were emblematic projects of this decade, those projects selected by specialized magazines and published.

The exhibition ends underlining a group of small works showing the work everytime more scattered of architects, moreover a small compilation of images enhancing all the contributions of this decade to the main questions that now and always have bothered Architecture: Light, space, materials, constructions ...
