Conservation of The Forth Bridge

In the second of our 'build-up' events Miles Oglethorpe will present on the challenges and lessons learnt in conserving The Forth Bridge.

Miles Oglethorpe is Head of Industrial Heritage at Historic Environment Scotland. After graduating from the University of Durham, he completed his PhD at the University of Glasgow, subsequently joining Strathclyde University's Scottish Industrial Archaeology Survey Unit in 1983 where he worked for Professor John R Hume. In 1985 he joined the Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Scotland in Edinburgh, from where he moved to Historic Scotland in 2007.

He has since fulfilled a number of key roles there, including Head of Education, Outreach and Publications, Deputy Chief Inspector, and Head of Policy. He has been a Board member of The International Committee on the Conservation of the Industrial Heritage (TICCIH) since 2003, is a technical assessor for the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), and is a Fellow both of the RSA and of the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland.
